Disinfecting Instructions

• Use Mermet approved household brand disinfectants per the manufacturer's instructions for application and contact time, combined with the cleaning best practices listed below.

Cleaning Instructions

- 1. Gentle: Dust can be removed easily by using a soft duster, clean cloth, sponge, compressed air or low-suction vacuum. Apply pressure, keeping the fabric flat to prevent fabric distortion
- 2. Moderate: For minor stains, clean with a few drops of mild dish detergent (e.g. Dawn) per 8oz of lukewarm water using a soft brush, cloth or sponge.
- 3. Strong: If the fabric has mold, mildew or severe stains, spot clean using a mixture of 10% diluted bleach-based cleaner (e.g. Clorox) and 90% water or use disinfecting wipes.

Cleaning - Best Practices

- When possible, remove the blind and clean the fabric on a clean flat horizontal surface rather than attempting to clean a free-hanging shade. Otherwise, use a flat surface to provide a stable plane to apply pressure against. Test chemicals in a small unnoticeable section first.
- Following the use of Mermet approved chemicals on the surface of the fabric, rinse with clean water on front and back of the fabric thoroughly. If any odor or tackiness of the fabric remains, rinse again.
- Dry the fabric with a soft clean cloth and leave the blind hanging down until completely dry.

Water and other wet cleaning methods are NOT recommended as they may leave water stains. Only **Gentle** level cleaning methods are recommended. Dirty spots may be removed with a natural rubber dry-cleaning sponge.
